Spectators Code of Conduct

Purpose

The purpose of this document is to outline what is expected from spectators of Cheshire Wire Basketball Club matches as all spectators have a responsibility to act according to the highest standards of integrity and to ensure that the reputation of our club and the sport of basketball is beyond reproach.

NB. The code of conduct outlined in this document is in line with the guidance issued by Basketball England.

The Code of Conduct

All spectators of Cheshire Wire Basketball Club games agree to

- Not use offensive, discriminatory or obscene language or gestures. Do not harass or verbally abuse players, coaches, match officials or fellow spectators in any form
- Treat everyone equally and sensitively
- Condemn the use of violence in all forms and refrain from any violent or aggressive behaviour
- Show respect for opponents and match officials
- Acknowledge good performance and fair play by opponents as well as by their own team
- Remember the players are taking part for their enjoyment and not theirs
- Not ridicule players who make mistakes
- Not over emphasise the importance of winning
- Not enter the court area unless authorised to do so
